The 2022 camping rates for this facility as set by the Marwayne Legion are as follows for all sites:

\$35 per night (per camping unit)

Winter: \$40 per night

\$200 per week or \$800 per month

\$225 per week or \$900 per month

These rates, as in any campground, are **payable in advance**, and ***any fees that are not paid in advance will be charged at the daily rate.***

If you would like to take advantage of the weekly or monthly rates and find that you will be leaving before the term is up, we will refund the difference. Cash or cheques are accepted, Visa, MC & Interac are accepted at the Hardware. ***Interac will be accepted up to \$200 at the Liquor Store but for larger credit card payments please make them at the Hardware.***

Please stop and register at the Hardware or the Liquor Store downtown:

Hardware: 9:00am to 5:00pm - Mon to Sat (847-3784)

Liquor Store: 10:00am to 6:00pm - Mon to Sat and
Noon to 5:00pm Sundays (847-4636)

Sites 1 to 16 have full water & sewer hookups (summer only) and 30-amp power. Winter camping is available, without water. There will be an increase in rates of \$25/week to partially cover extra power for heating from October to March.

There are 8 “overflow” sites backing on to sites 9 to 16 which have water and sewer but only 15-amp power. They are numbered from 9A to 16A. The same rates apply to these sites.

If you trip your power breaker the panels are accessible at the rear of site 4 for sites 1 to 8 and at the rear of site 12 for sites 9 to 16 and sites 9A to 16A.

No charge washrooms & showers for your use are located on the northwest corner of the Community Hall building. The access code for them will be provided when you register. Currently, local fire regulations do not permit open campfires in the RV park, but portable propane units are fine.

There is no individual garbage collection in the campground and the garbage container, located between the arena and community hall, has been placed for your use. Please ensure that waste is bagged to prevent it blowing around. If any complains are received regarding the appearance of your site, it will be cleaned up by village or Legion personnel and charged to your account.

Propane is available at the Car Wash on Railway Ave; Coin Laundry is located on Center St. along with two Grocery outlets that are open late and Fuel and Restaurant on 897 south
