HOLIDAY STRATEGIES FOR THE BEREAVED

We acknowledge that this is the season of joy and when focus is on family and the gift.

Not all are experiencing a sense of joy and looking forward to the special day. For those who grieve a life loss and the death of someone loved (in their family circle) it will be a day of sadness and emptiness. The season will happen and the day will come no matter how you grieve.

Some STRATEGIES that Margaret Robinson has put together to share and help move through the holidays with comfort and less anxiety are listed:

Acknowledge the holiday season will be different and difficult. Plan – don't drift (the worse forebodings are never the reality).

- * Accept your limitations.
- * Give yourself permission to make changes and eliminate activities that may be too painful/stressful for this Christmas. Create new traditions- a picture on the tree, a special angel , remembrance candle- something that is meaningful to you.
- * Make Christmas a season (Dec. 1st to Jan. 7th).
- * Do only one thing at a time. (don't try multitasking)
- * Choose activities that bring peace and joy , not pain and chaos.
- * Don't overspend to compensate, whether you are spending time, money or energy .
- * Plan your shopping ahead. Make a list, go on a good day, shop online or catalogue or ask a friend to accompany you.
- * The tree symbolizes the permanency of love and continuation of life. Getting the tree up is half the battle. Do it early,
- * perhaps invite friends to help, choose a different place and involve children.
- * Take time to discuss with family what everyone wishes for, and compromise , if necessary to meet most of everyone's
- * needs.
- * Be honest with your feelings – with everyone else, and especially yourself.
- * Keep children informed, always, and tell them the truth and cry together.
- * Accept the grieving process. Be non-judgmental of family members or friends whose grief may be expressed different
- * that your.
- * Plan to be with people whose company you enjoy .
- * When at social outings give yourself permission to do what you need to do; leave early, bow out.
- * Remember self care; eat nutritionally, exercise, buy a "me" gift and attend a social event , if you can.
- * Laugh if you can (watch a funny movie)
- * Change family traditions around (gift giving, opening, location of family dinner) Maybe just for this year.
- * Reminisce with albums or pictures and celebrate the relationships.
- * At the meal light a memory candle and mention their name, say a prayer and share a memory.
- * Visit the grave site with family and place a decoration, pray or be silent in memory.
- * Give a gift in your loved one's name, a donation to food bank or flowers to a care centre. Give a gift of time to someone
- * alone this year, too.
- * Let people know your needs. Be gracious in accepting the out stretched hand.
- * Don't "should " on yourself.
- * Remember nothing is set in stone, you can change anything next year.
- * With these thoughts and support you will COPE.
