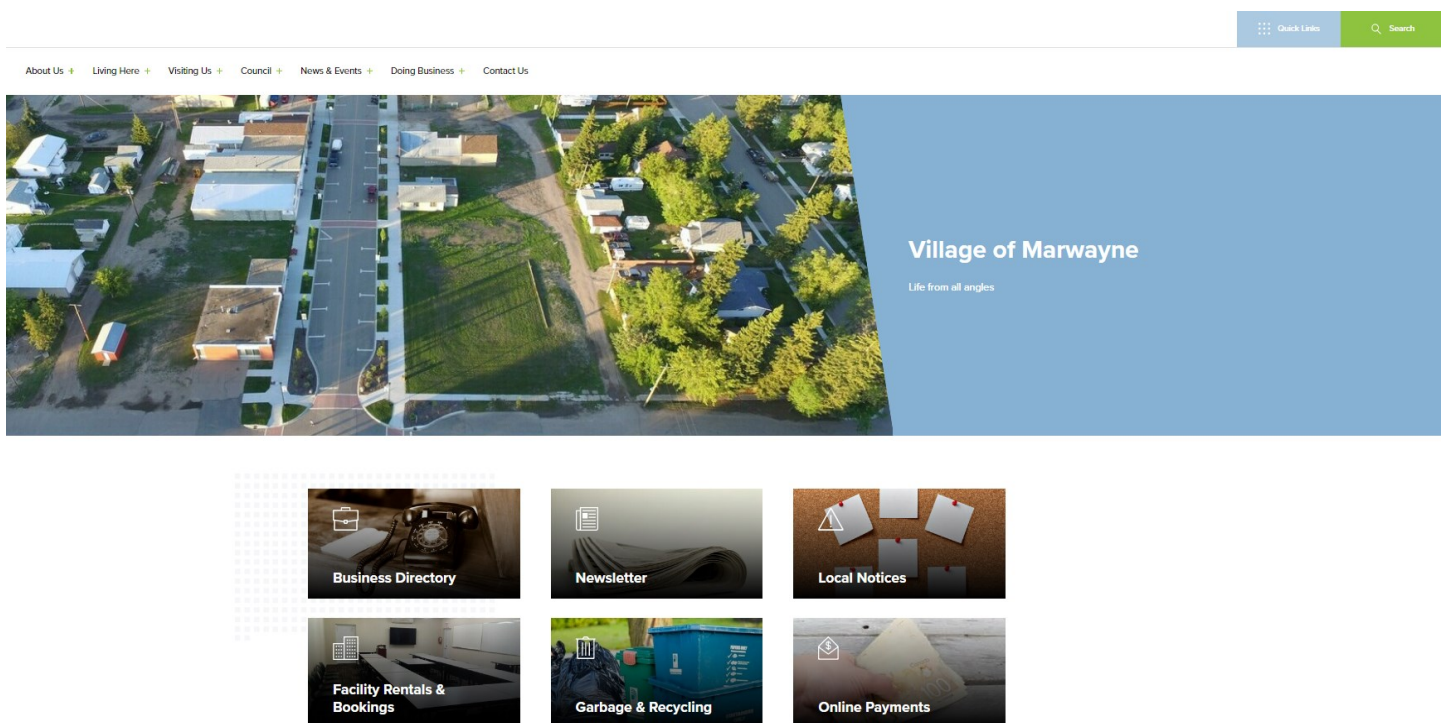

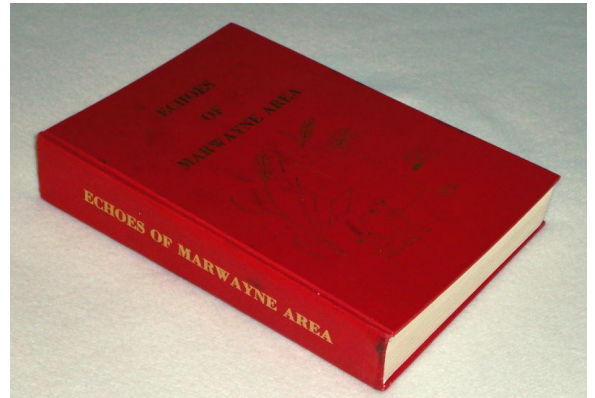
## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHT

- Sergeant Corey Buckingham from the Kitscoty RCMP presented the 2022 Quarter 1 policing statistics to Council at the August 15th, 2022 Regular Council Meeting.
- Council adopted the Council Composition Bylaw No. 591-22. This bylaw establishes that the number of Councillors on the Village Council will be reduced from five (5) to three (3) as per the Municipal Government Act. This change will take effect in advance of the next general municipal election.
- The Village retained Lloyd's Limb Services to complete tree maintenance throughout the community.
- Council passed a motion to change the frequency of monthly meetings from two (2) to one (1). Council meetings will typically be scheduled on the third Monday of each month moving forward!
- The back alley adjacent to 5th Street Close and 4th Avenue North will be closed from September 15th to September 22nd (subject to change) for the walking trail trajectory construction. There will be no access to the back alley until construction has been completed. Please ensure to move any vehicles and/or belongings you may require during that time.

# Projects at a Glance

## WALKING TRAILS

In 2020, the Village of Marwayne began construction of our 6 foot wide asphalt walking trail system. Since then, we've been able to expand the trajectory throughout the community and look forward to adding another 1000 linear meters this fall. The map to the right showcases the Village's current walking trail trajectory as well as highlights where it will be going starting in September of 2022. We wish to acknowledge and thank the adjacent landowners, the Federal Government who made this project possible through the Canada Community Revitalization Fund Program as well as our contractors—ASL Paving Ltd.— who were awarded the contract for the project.



## SPLASH PARK

The equipment has been ordered for the splash park which will break ground this fall. Using local contractors, PlayQuest will be heading up the project which was also made possible by the Federal Government through the Canada Community Revitalization Fund Program. The splash park will feature 8 unique components for children of all ages and abilities. The splash park will be located in Westview Park, behind the manors, and easily accessible via the new walking trail system by the summer of 2023. Parking will be available on the nearby road allowances or a short distance away at the multiplex.

# Automated Bulk Water Station Fully Operational

The Village's new bulk water station system has been installed and is now available for use. Users can now access bulk water using a unique seven (7) digit pin. We offer two types of access when it comes to bulk water.

## **Option 1—Open an account**

If you choose to open an account, a refundable \$200.00 deposit must first be paid to the Village of Marwayne. Once received, you will be issued a unique seven (7) digit pin to access the bulk water station at your leisure. All bulk water account holders must complete a Bulk Water Account Holder Consent Form prior to access being granted. Invoices are generated monthly and must be paid within thirty (30) days.

**COST: \$40.00 monthly flat fee + \$6.50 per cubic meter of bulk water**

## **Option 2—One time use**

If you only need water for a specific purpose, or for a set number of days, we can set you up with a unique seven (7) digit pin that will be valid for a limited time. Users who would like to get bulk water on an as needed basis must complete a Bulk Water One Time Use Consent Form prior to access being granted. One time users will need to remit payment to the Village of Marwayne immediately after filling up, or at the conclusion of their agreement, whichever comes soonest.

**COST: \$6.50 per cubic meter of bulk water.** If bulk water access is required after hours, or on the weekend, an additional surcharge of \$25.00 will apply.

## **LAND TITLE DELAY – ALBERTA GOVERNMENT REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM FOR TAX**

Alberta Land Titles has been experiencing delays for 2022 registration of land title changes and subsequent notice to all municipalities for updating their tax rolls. This may result in incorrect owner information on municipal tax notices.

Alberta Land Title delays may also result in a situation where new property owners may not have received their annual tax notice(s) and therefore may not be aware of due dates and subsequent penalties for past due amounts.

To mitigate any financial loss resulting from such delays, the Government of Alberta has announced a reimbursement program. If you incur a penalty due to land title changes not being made on time, you may apply for reimbursement to Alberta Government.

### Utility and Tax Arrears

The Village of Marwayne would like to remind residents that it is their responsibility to ensure that utility accounts and property tax accounts are paid in full and on time. **The Village DOES NOT send reminders to residents regarding their overdue accounts.** Accruing utility balances in excess of \$250.00 are transferred to the associated tax roll for the property in default. This process also applies to properties that are being rented—meaning—if a renter is in default on their utility account, the balance will be transferred to the owners property tax account in accordance with the Village's bylaw and the Municipal Government Act legislation.

Residents are able to call the office at any time to obtain their balance for their utility account and/or property tax account. Keep in mind, all balances accruing on a utility account and/or property tax account are subject to penalties for non payment as well as administrative fees. These penalties and fees are non-negotiable.

Please ensure to keep your accounts current to avoid balance transfers, penalties, unforeseen charges and/or the tax recovery process.
