## REQUEST FOR COUNCIL DECISION

#### **SUBJECT**

Council Remuneration

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Be it resolved that the Village of Marwayne approve Option #\_\_\_\_\_ as the 2025 Council Remuneration Rates.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Village of Marwayne has historically had the same remuneration for Council roles and responsibilities. With an increase to the cost of living and a reduction in the amount of interested persons running for office, administration believes that our elected officials should be more financially compensated for the time they dedicate to making Marwayne a safe and viable community with a small-town quality of life.

#### **Current Schedule**

\$150.00 per meeting < 4 hours

\$250.00 per meeting > 4 hours

\$0.68 per km, as established by the Government of Canada annually

\$75.00 per day for meals with receipts

Highest yearly payment to date	\$5,650.00	(\$470.00/month)
Lowest yearly payment to date	\$2,800.00	(\$233.00/month)

#### Averages over the last 3 years

Deputy Mayor Rainey	\$3,985.00	(\$332.00/month)
Mayor Neureuter	\$3,394.00	(\$282.00/month)
(Retired) Councillor McDonald	\$3,262.00	(\$272.00/month)

#### **IMPLICATIONS**

A change in the remuneration schedule would have budgetary implications. However, based on our current budget and the annual costs over the last three years, a change in the payment structure would not necessarily result in a budget increase, but rather, a redistribution of funds.

#### Proposed Schedule(s)

#### Option 1 – Using Expense and Meeting Claim Forms

\$200.00 per meeting < 4 hours (increase of \$50.00/meeting)

\$300.00 per meeting > 4 hours (increase of \$50.00/meeting)

KM Rate as established by the Canada Revenue Agency annually (currently \$0.70/km)

\$75.00 per day without receipts or reimbursed with receipts over \$75.00 to a maximum of \$120.00 per day

\$300.00 for additional duties as performed by the Mayor
